### Atlanta Global Studies Center Domestic Travel Grants & International Travel Grants

The Atlanta Global Studies Center announces the Faculty Travel Grant competition for Spring/Summer 2019. Established in 2018, The Atlanta Global Studies Center (AGSC) is a partnership of Georgia Institute of Technology and Georgia State University. The interdisciplinary center supports research, curriculum enhancement, and faculty professional development in global studies and language learning.

AGSC faculty travel grants are designed to support the professional development of Georgia State and Georgia Tech faculty. Funding can be used for research travel or to present a paper at an academic conference. Grants for international travel are in the amount of \$2,500 and grants for domestic travel are \$500, each. All travel expense submissions must be completed no later than August 12, 2019. Please note that any international travel must be approved by the US Department of Education 30 days in advance of a scheduled flight and confirm to the Fly America act. This travel grant is funded by the US Department of Education Title VI grant.

Applications are open to all faculty ranks. Preference will be given to applicants who are junior or at early stages in their career, or who have limited access to research or conference travel support. Travel award recipients may be invited to present a brown bag talk at an AGSC lecture series, or share their research at the annual Atlanta Global Studies Symposium. Grant funds may be used for airfare, lodging, per diem, conference registration fees, etc.

Applications should include one copy of the following documents:

- A one-page proposal with a description of the proposed travel and the expected benefits to your research and the general area of global studies;
- A budget for the travel and conference expenses;
- For conference travel, please attach a copy of the announcement of the conference and a notice showing that the proposed paper has been accepted for the conference;
- A brief 2-page curriculum vitae.

Announcement of awards will be made by March 4, 2019.
