ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Incorporating "real world" connections into college courses can make content more relevant to students, enhancing motivation. The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) offers a framework to help students make connections between their disciplinary knowledge and skills and the world's most pressing challenges. The UN SDGs can be incorporated into any course, regardless of discipline.

The <u>RCE Greater Atlanta</u>'s Higher Education Learning Community invites you to a virtual workshop designed to help instructors incorporate the SDGs into their teaching. In the workshop, several faculty members will briefly share their experiences with SDG integration. Then, we will break into small groups organized according to participant experience and goals. Facilitators with course design and SDG teaching experience will provide support and resources as you work on designing your own lessons and units. A short questionnaire in the registration form will help us organize the breakout groups appropriately.
