When someone has agreed to write you a recommendation letter, please provide him/her with the instructions below. It is your responsibility to contact your referee(s), provide instructions, follow up, and make sure that your recommendation letter is submitted by the deadline. You will receive an email confirmation when a letter is submitted.

Instructions for Letters of Recommendation:

The FLAS Fellowship recommendation letter should be 1-2 pages in length and should be written by a teacher, advisor, or employer who can comment on the applicant's academic potential. One letter should come from a language instructor. Additional letters do not need to directly comment on the applicant's language skills. Rather, the writer should describe the applicant's academic performance, motivation, potential, and interest in foreign language and global studies. All recommendation letters must be submitted using the FLAS Recommendation Letter Submission Link. Deadline: 11:59 p.m. EST on June 30, 2022.
