The Atlanta Global Studies Center announces a Faculty Travel Grant competition for Academic Year 2024/25. These grants are designed to support faculty research and development. Funding can be used for research travel, conference attendance, or other work relating to global studies and/or language education. Grants for international travel are in the amount of \$1500-\$2500, and grants for domestic travel are \$500-\$1000 each (AGSC reserves the right to modify the number and amounts of the awards if the applications so warrant).

All international travel plans must be submitted for approval by the US Department of Education **45 days in advance** of a scheduled flight and must comply with the Fly America Act or an Open Skies Agreement. This reason, international travel can only take place beginning 15 October, 2024. All travel must be completed and all expense reimbursements must be processed by no later than August 14, 2025.

Travel award recipients may be invited to present at an AGSC Research Seminar or the annual [Atlanta Global Studies Symposium](#). Grant funds may be used for airfare, lodging, per diem, conference registration fees, etc.

Applications should include:

- A draft itinerary including dates and cities
- A short description of the expected benefits to your research and the general area of global studies and/or language and intercultural studies
- A draft budget

Deadline for full consideration: Aug 25, 2024
